Awards

On successful completion of the course, students will be awarded a LLB (Hons) Law (with Study Abroad).

Students who leave the course early may be eligible for a LLB Law on successful completion of 300 credits including all mandatory modules at levels 4 and 5 and at least 60 credits at level 6, a DipHE Law on successful completion of 240 credits including all mandatory modules at levels 4 and 5, or a CertHE Law on successful completion of 120 credits including all mandatory modules at level 4.

Course Delivery

The course is delivered at Ipswich main campus. Students studying full-time on LLB (Hons) Law (with Study Abroadroad
